5+1 Challenges





States must adopt news tools to provides effective and high quality public services, and earn trust through accountable, transparent, and efficient governance.



To attain decent living standards for everyone, we have established three key levels: rebuilding economically challenged areas, fostering leadership in innovation, and pushing for the EU to become a "Social Union".



EU citizens and residents need to be guaranteed equal rights and opportunities, and human rights need to be respected and applied



The European Union needs to assume responsibility for its role in global challenges, especially regarding climate change, food and water security, public health, migration and refugee crises.



Europeans need to be empowered to take informed political decisions, be able to influence politics beyond elections within vibrant, resilient, and highly deliberative democracies.



We want to reform and strengthen EU governance and institutions for a truly democratic federal Europe, and propose concrete policies for more efficient and transparent EU action.



The Amsterdam Declaration was approved on 27th of October 2018 during our General Assembly in Amsterdam.
